DISPOSITIVE MOTIONS ORDER No. 7-A

Defendants C.R. Bard, Inc. and Davol, Inc. seek summary judgment on Plaintiff Aaron Stinson's manufacturing defect claim. At the request of the parties, the Court previously reserved ruling on this portion of the motion due to ongoing discovery concerning a line fire in one of Defendants' manufacturing facilities (*see* Dispositive Motions Order No. 7, ECF No. 225 at PageID #9115). Plaintiff has indicated to the Court that he is withdrawing the manufacturing defect claim and will not pursue it at trial. Therefore, Defendants' motion (ECF No. 89) as it relates to the manufacturing defect claim is **DENIED AS MOOT**.
